

Vehicle Mount

User Guide



The Vehicle Mount has been designed for using the Active 10 GPS unit in motor vehicles and is suitable for any windshield or flat surface (such as the dashboard using the adhesive Mounting Plate). It is suitable for off-road motoring where accurate topographical mapping is required and can also be used to provide map detail for general motoring.

Important: We recommend that you do not adjust the Mount or operate your unit while driving as this could seriously impact the safety of you and others on the road. Please set up the Vehicle Mount before starting your journey, pull over somewhere safe to adjust it, or ask a passenger for help.

Getting Started

1. Take the Vehicle Mount (**B**) and slide the Adaptor Plate (**A**) onto the Mount head. Make sure the edges of the Adaptor Plate and Mount head line up exactly and click firmly in place. Note: If you are able to slide the Adaptor Plate over the edge it is upside down. Remove, turn plate around and slide into place. Ensure the Adaptor Plate always has the opening facing upwards (**E**).
2. Make sure the windscreen is clean. Place the suction cup (**F**) against the windscreen with the locking tab facing upwards.
3. If using the Mounting Plate (**C**) on the dashboard: Remove the plastic film to reveal the adhesive surface, make sure the dashboard is clean and then stick the Mounting Plate to the dashboard. The Mounting Plate then acts as a support for attaching the Mount to and will allow the suction cup to stick to it.
4. When the Mount is in the desired position, push the locking tab away from you towards the windscreen to lock the Mount into place and secure it onto the glass (**G**).

Attaching the Mount Battery Back

- K** Unlock
- L** Lock

1. You will need to replace the Standard Battery Back on the Active 10 with a Mount Battery Back that has a clip for mounting.
2. Lift the metal D-ring on the back of the Active 10 and rotate counter-clockwise to an unlocked position (**K**) and lift the back off.
3. Place the Mount Battery Back onto the back of the unit (**M**). Make sure you locate the tab at the base and slide it into the unit first.
4. Rotate the metal D-ring clockwise to the lock position (**L**) to secure the Mount Battery Back into place. (You may need to press down gently to turn it).

Fixing the Active 10 to the Vehicle Mount:

1. Take the Active 10 attached to the Mount Battery Back (**H**) and slide it into place via the Adaptor Plate (**E**).
2. It does not need to click into place but as long as the opening on the plate is at the top, the unit will be kept firmly in place by the ridge at the bottom.
3. To remove the Active 10, simply lift it upwards out of the Adaptor Plate.

Adjusting the Vehicle Mount

With a powerful suction cup for fixing onto smooth surfaces, the Vehicle Mount can also be adjusted at three different points, and rotated at 360° for maximum visibility and comfort.

1. Use the knobs on the Mount to loosen and position it for best visibility of the GPS screen. It is possible to rotate the unit 360° (**I**), and to adjust the plate and head by turning it left and right and up and down (**J**).
2. When removing the Vehicle Mount, always remember to pull the locking tab back towards you in order to release the Mount from the windshield. Failing to do so could damage the Mount.

Note: We recommend removing the Vehicle Mount and the Active 10 from your vehicle when unattended as this could attract attention from thieves.



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
